## Guided Interpretive Hike: Avalanche Peak

Origin: MH VT-122

**Wednesday, July 28<sup>th</sup> – Meet in the Tower Dorm Lobby at 8:00 am**

**Cost: \$5 Space is limited – Must pay in advance to reserve a seat**

***Distance: 4 miles – Hiking Time: 4 hours – Difficulty: Strenuous***

At 10,566 feet, you'll feel like you're on top of the world! The summit provides impressive views of Yellowstone Lake and the Absaroka Mountain Range. Pikas are known to make their home on the rocky slopes so keep a lookout! ***\*\*This hike is very strenuous and steep, so anyone with knee or cardio-respiratory problems should refrain from coming.\*\****

## Guided Hike: Riddle Lake & Swimming at Moose Falls

***Distance: 4.5 miles – Hiking Time: 1.5 hours – Difficulty: Moderate***

This fairly level trail crosses the Continental Divide and passes through small meadows. It ends up at the scenic Riddle Lake with Mt. Sheridan and the rest of the Red Mountains in the background. Afterwards, we'll take a refreshing dip in the swimming hole at the bottom of the impressive Moose Falls!

## Guided Interpretive Hike: Specimen Ridge

***Distance: 11.4 miles – Hiking Time: 7 hours – Difficulty: Moderately Strenuous***

This trip combines two of Yellowstone's most scenic and memorable hikes. Look down into the Grand Canyon of the Yellowstone from the Picnic Trail and see the awe-inspiring rock spires, osprey nests and the Yellowstone River as it continues to carve the canyon. Later, hike to some of the best, if not the best, fossilized trees in the park. Definitely a day to remember!
