Nestled at the foot of the Beartooths, where the mountains meet the clouds, Slough Creek purls its way through four meadows and some of the most spectacular scenery in Yellowstone. Slough Creek is also known for its cutthroat trout waters which are rumored to be the some of the best in the world! With hatches such as the green & gray drake mayflies, little yellow & golden stoneflies, *lepidostoma* caddis, and plenty of various terrestrials the trout will be hungry for our flies! The trip will include an instructional portion to shake the dust off for rusty fly casters and to show the beginners how it's done. The rod and reel setup will be provided for participants, courtesy of YCERP. However, you are encouraged to bring your own rod and reel if you already have the equipment. ***Bring: a valid fishing permit available at all visitor centers, a small selection of flies which are available at our sporting goods store (once you signup the recreation staff will give you a list of flies to acquire), proper hiking boots that can get wet, rain gear, a liter of water, and a form of glasses for eye protection, and a sack lunch for dinner.***
